

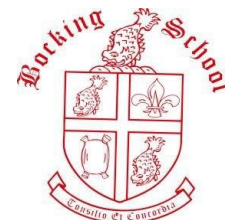

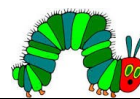

Monday	Chicken iltalienne (breast of chicken topped with tomato sauce/cheese) Wholegrain and white rice Jacket Potato with cheese and/or baked beans Fruit crumble/custard or yoghurt
Tuesday	Sausages/onion gravy or quorn toad in the hole Parsley potatoes/carrots/whole green beans Chocolate Arctic Roll or muller yoghurt
Wednesday	Roast gammon/Yorkshire pudding/gravy Or Golden vegetable loaf Roast potatoes/peas/cauliflower cheese/carrots Fresh fruit salad or muller yoghurt
Thursday	Beef bolognaise with macaroni/golden cheese sauce Homemade garlic bread Homemade shortbread and glass of cold milk or yoghurt
