



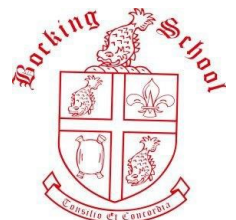

This week, as I have visited classes it has been a real pleasure to have seen the children demonstrating our values of being *responsible* and *ready* during their learning. Well done everybody.

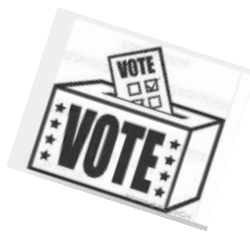
Thank you our lunch team for a delicious Harvest lunch on Tuesday.
