Our evening performance for Straw and Order is at 6pm on **Tuesday 12th December**. Please could we ask that the children are back in school for **5:30pm**?

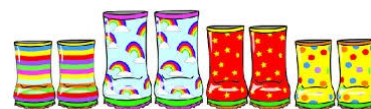

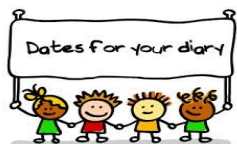
