Just a reminder that our Harvest Festival is next week!

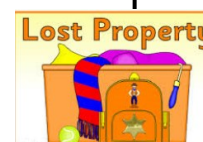
Please join us for our celebrations at **St Mary's Church on Friday 7th October at either 10.30am or 2.00pm.**

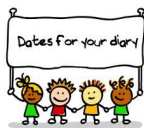
