

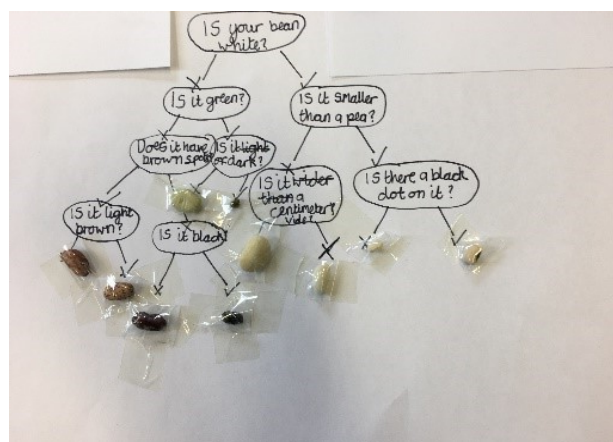

Bella from Year 5 has won for the second week running! - Amazing Job Bella.











Children are required to bring water bottle and fruit snack daily (Infants have snack provided).

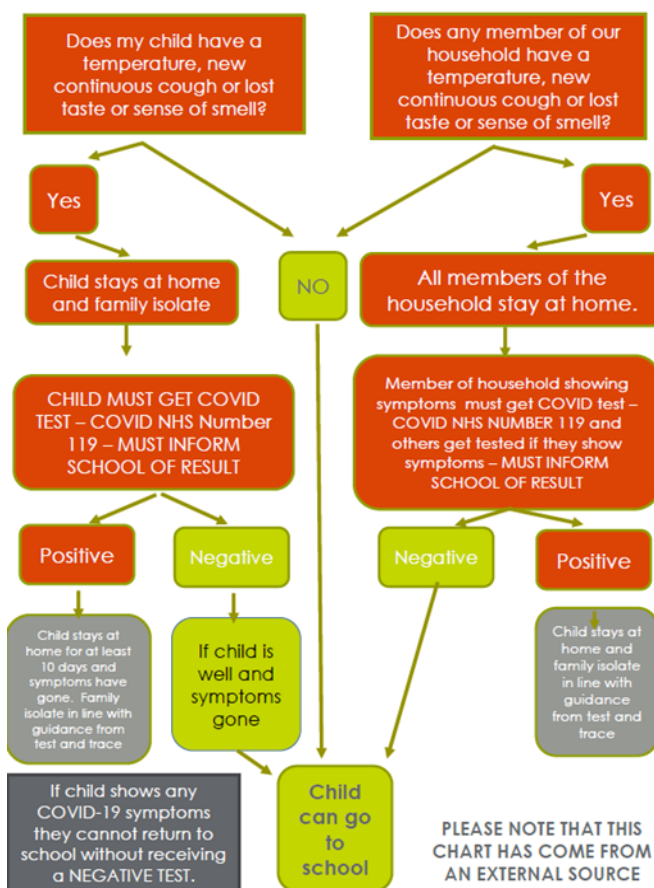
