

Sports Premium Funding. Review for 2018-19

During the financial year, 2018 – 2019 Bocking Primary school received Sports Premium funding of £20,107 made up of £18,020 grant for academic year 2018/19 and a carry forward from 2017/18 of £2,087. We spent it on the following areas:

To develop our outdoor learning Space: £5, 043

Every class now has one day of outdoor learning a half term and classes are beginning to use the outdoor learning space in other lessons too. This has encouraged children to be active and has created more memorable learning experiences.

To improve the teaching of PE by employing a specialist coach: £4880

This has enabled all classes to benefit from expert teaching, helping to raise attainment and progress in PE. Every class receives at least one hour of PE a week with the specialist coach.

To transport children to more sporting competitions: £880

We have taken part in football, swimming and athletic local competitions, winning both Championships in the District Sports event for Key Stage 2. 55 children attend either the KS1 or KS2 District sports.

Release time for the PE coordinator: £500

This has allowed the PE coordinator release time to monitor planning and lessons and to attend CPD and relevant meetings.

To Develop Dance Skills and Opportunity: £150

All Upper Key Stage 2 children participated in a dance programme provided by external dance teachers to celebrate 100 years since end of WW2. This culminated in a number of public performances across the Braintree area.

Updating and expanding P.E. and sports equipment: £6279

We used some of our funding to inspect, repair and replace existing equipment. We also completed a thorough analysis of our equipment and made purchases where necessary to enable our staff to

deliver high quality PE lessons and we held a successful sports day using new equipment. We have also invested in replacing all the safety flooring on the outdoor gym equipment.

Increase Opportunity for Access to Sports Competitions and CPD: £750

Membership of the local North West Essex Sports Partnership.

Additional swimming lessons for non-swimmers: £100

We used some funding to allow non swimmers in years 4, 5 and 6 to attend additional swimming lessons.

Carry Forward to Academic Year 2019/20 is £1,525.
