

## **Sports Premium Funding. Plans for 2020 - 2021**

During the financial year, 2020 - 2021 Bocking Primary school plans to spend our funding of £25,340 (approx.) on the following areas:

### **To improve the teaching of PE by using a specialist coach: £7168**

This will enable all classes to benefit from expert teaching, helping to raise attainment and progress in PE. Every class will participate in one hour of PE a week with the specialist coach.

### **To enable more children to participate in sporting competitions: £3000**

We hope, with support from the sports coach, to take part in more sporting competitions in the local area which will allow more children to represent our school and improve their sporting skills. This also included the purchase of a new team kit for children to wear when proudly representing our school.

### **Release time for the PE Lead: £1500**

To allow the PE coordinator release time to monitor planning and lessons and to attend CPD and relevant meetings.

### **Updating and expanding P.E. and sports equipment: £3668**

We will use some of our funding to inspect, repair and replace existing equipment including our assault trail. We will also complete a thorough analysis of our equipment and make purchases where necessary to enable our staff to deliver high quality PE lessons and for children to be active in their break times.

### **Additional swimming lessons for non-swimmers: £2000**

We will use some funding to allow non swimmers in years 5 and 6 to attend additional swimming lessons.

### **Membership of the local Partnership: £750**

The partnership helps us to develop PE and sport in the school and allows us to enter local competitions.

**CPD / Staff training: £2000**

All teaching staff to receive training in effectively using our PE scheme- REAL PE. This will enable all staff to deliver high quality PE lessons.

**PSHE scheme of work: £1200**

This was purchased last year but due to Covid 19 is to be financed this year. This scheme of work helps staff to teach children the importance of healthy body and mind and focuses on wellbeing and activities such as mindful yoga.

**Free participation in Sports clubs for Pupil Premium children: £500**

Eligible children can attend our sports clubs without payment.
