Create a poster summarising the features of a non-choronlogical report. Can you give examples that would work well in our key text? Remember to think about the features studied in our key text on the Lost Cities of Ancient Maya	Create a toolkit for a new process we have learnt. You can choose from using the inverse, multiplication, division, addition, subtraction, area or perimeter. Use pictures and key words to explain the process clearly. Do this like our toolkits that we make in class	Where about in the world did Mayan's live? Use a map to find out. Can you plot different Mayan cities on the map? You could use an atlas of google maps to do this
Create a mind map listing Mayan Gods. Then write about what they all have in common and what differences they have.
