Sports Premium Funding. Review for 2019-20

Note: The school closed due to Covid in March 2020 and reopened in September 2020.

During the financial year, 2019 – 2020 Bocking Primary school spent £27,066 of funding on the following areas:

To improve the teaching of PE by employing a specialist coach: £10,578

This enabled all classes to benefit from expert teaching, helping to raise attainment and progress in PE. Every class participated in two hours of PE a week with the specialist coach.

To transport children to more sporting competitions: £665

We took part in more sporting competitions in the local area which allowed more children to represent our school and improve their sporting skills.

Updating and expanding P.E. and sports equipment: £1350

We used some of our funding to inspect, repair and replace existing equipment. We also bought various equipment to enable our staff to deliver high quality PE lessons.

Additional swimming lessons for non-swimmers: £0

Due to Covid 19, we were unable to carry out planned additional swimming lessons for nonswimmers in the summer term.

Repair and addition of soft flooring: £5750

Soft and safe matting was replaced underneath the obstacle trail and in the EYFS outdoor learning space to allow children to safely use the monkey bars and so that the EYFS children can play safely in their outdoor learning space.

To purchase and implement a whole school scheme of work for PSHE- £0

In mindfulness of the importance of healthy body and healthy mind, the school was in need of a PSHE scheme of work to become a healthier school. This will include the introduction of the daily mile across the school. Due to Covid 19, the cost of this has been carried forward to next year.

Membership of Sports Partnership: £750

We joined our local Sports Partnership which helps organise competitions, holds network meetings and offers training and guidance in all PE matters.
