





### Is there a Young Carer in your family who you think may benefit from support in school?

A Young Carer is anyone between five and eighteen years whose life is in some way restricted because of the need to take responsibility for the care of a person on a regular basis.

The person being cared for may have a long-term illness, a physical or sensory impairment, learning difficulties, mental illness or be affected by alcohol/substance misuse. This may be a parent, brother or sister, grandparent, or another family member.

#### Our Young Carer School Service can provide:

- One-to-one support sessions in school giving Young Carers the opportunity to talk confidentially to somebody who understands their situation
- Practical help such as providing support in meetings with teachers, for example to explain why they are having difficulties completing homework
- Informal drop-in sessions where Young Carers can meet others in the same situation and access information and advice
- Information on how to access respite Young Carer Clubs in the local area where Young Carers can meet other young people in the same situation.
