

Write a list of what you would take with you and how you would prepare.</p> <p><i>For example, you might take sun cream or prepare by having ice baths!</i></p>
<p>Write a non-chron report on any subject you like.</p> <p><i>For example: school, your house, your family, lunch times.</i></p>	<p>Roll two dice and multiply the two numbers together. Add them together too. Which is larger?</p> <p><i>For example, if you roll a 3 and a 6. <math>3 + 6 = 9</math>. <math>3 \times 6 = 18</math>. <math>18 &gt; 9</math>.</i></p>	<p>Construct a home to live in Kenya or the Arctic.</p> <p><i>This could be drawn, made from lego or made from anything you have at home</i></p>
