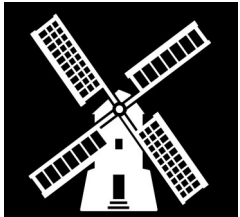

Remember to use your capital letters, finger spaces, full stops, neat handwriting and phonics.</p>	<p>Once you are confident with number bonds to 10, practice writing your number bonds to 20 as number sentences - $15+5=20$ etc. Can you find all the ways to make 20? Use objects around your house to help you if you need too. Can you put them into a part whole model too?</p>	<p>In Science we are learning all about Materials, go on a materials hunt around your house. What can you find that is made from wood, plastic, metal or glass. Write them down to show your friends in class. You may want to draw pictures too.</p>

It could be a new hobby you'd like to learn, something you are going to give up, or something you are going to do more of.</p>	<p>Practice writing your number bonds to 10 as a number sentence - $2+8=10$ etc. Can you find all the ways to make 10?
