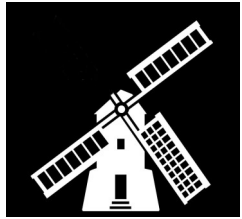
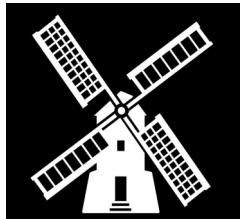

<p>As we are learning all about our bodies in Science this term, I would like you to write sentences to describe different parts of your body. For example: I can run with my long legs. I can read with my green eyes. I can use my small hands to hold a pencil. I have long dark brown hair.</p> <p>Please remember to include adjectives to describe your body parts and to try to write at least 5 sentences. I look forward to reading your work!</p>	<p>Collect 6 different bottles/containers of different shapes and sizes from around your house - a jug, cup, glass, mug, bowl etc, label each container with a number or letter. Play a game where each person looks at each container carefully and orders them from which they think has the largest capacity, to the smallest capacity, or vice versa. Each person writes down their order in secret. Once all players have done this, fill each container full and together, measure the amount of liquid in each container to see who is correct. Did you discover anything unusual? Were your estimates correct? Write down one thing that you learnt when doing this..</p>	<p>In Science we are learning all about our bodies and our senses. Can you create a fact file poster all about the human body. It must include a title, a picture, and 4 facts! You can bring it to school to add to our body display!</p>
<p>Choose your favourite book and read it or you may want a grown up to read it to you. Then create a book review all about that book. It must include: the title, the author, what the book was about, what your favourite part was and a star rating out of 5. You can bring this into school to add to our library!</p>	<p>Go to https://www.deeeningunderstanding.co.uk/ and log in to your account using your username and password that is stuck into the front of your reading diary. Complete the 'Compare Capacity' task assigned to you.</p>	<p>In Science we are learning all about our bodies and our 5 senses. Using your sense of taste have a go at a taste experiment! Ask your grown up to pick 5 tasty foods/ingredients in your house without you seeing, then close your eyes and taste each food without peeking! Write down what you think it is and describe it, then open your eyes and see if you were correct! Repeat this for all of your foods.</p>
<p>Write 3 or more sentences about something you have done over the weekend.</p> <p>Remember to use your capital letters, finger spaces, full stops, neat handwriting and phonics.</p>	<p>Go to https://www.deeeningunderstanding.co.uk/ and log in to your account using your username and password that is stuck into the front of your reading diary. Complete the 'Count in 5s' task assigned to you.</p>	<p>In History we are learning all about Kings and Queens. Create your own piece of artwork of our Queen. This could be a drawing, a painting, a collage. Bring it to school to add to our display!</p>
<p>Go to Phonics Play website - https://www.phonicsplay.co.uk/resources/phase/5/dragons-den and Play the 'Buried Treasure' game with all phase 5 sounds!
