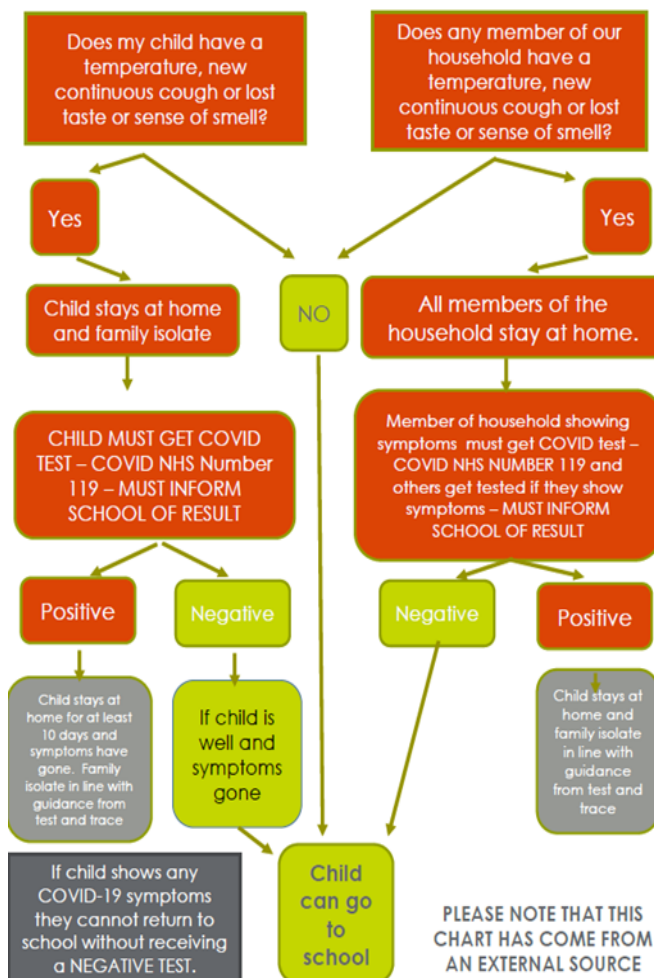
The School photographer is booked for 21st May. We will be unable have sibling that do not attend school. Photos will be ordered online through PSP Ltd, and details will be given to you.
