When collecting your child at the end of the day we ask that they stay with you, if you are waiting for an older sibling. We are not able to use the outdoor play equipment or outdoor learning area currently, therefore the children <u>should not</u> play on these

while waiting on the playground. We also ask that you ensure that you respect the social distancing guidelines.
