CLASSROOM NEWS

From Year 3

Year 3 have had a very busy and exciting week. After Sports day on Monday, we have been learning a short excerpt from Mozart's The Magic Flute. We completed an online session lead by the Royal Opera House, then learnt the song and tried to stage it ourselves. We then joined a live session with other schools from around the country. The children were surprised by how much they enjoyed singing in an opera style. We also have loved learning about Boudica, the Queen of the Iceni and how she burnt Colchester to the ground.

From Year 4

In Year 4 we have finished writing our non chronological reports and have completed an independent write all about the Amazon rainforest. We then turned it into a beautiful double page spread with pictures and colour to draw the readers' attention. In Maths we have been learning all about angles and shapes. We created a WANTED poster to help identify the different quadrilaterals and where you might find them in everyday life. In topic the children have created some amazing work, transforming a shoebox into a rainforest. Everyone demonstrated great teamwork and creativity and this really shows in the final product.



From Year 5

This week Year 5 have looked very closely at a range of Claude Monet's water artwork. The class have investigated Monet's use of shade, tones and intensity of colours. The children then created a wax relief piece of their own by using wax crayon to depict water lilies and then brushed water paints over the top to give the illusion of the surrounding water. We looked at different blending techniques to create our masterpieces and discussed which one we though were most effective and why.







From Year 6

Year 6 are counting the days until they begin their new chapter at secondary school, so we want to make every second count. We are in the final stages of our rehearsals and enjoying dressing up in, wigs and props! We have also had our last swimming lesson this week and have completed our PSHE on relationships. In our Science we have been investigating conductors and insulators and making circuits using bulbs and motors. Next week we will start the countdown to the end of term and will be wearing our Leavers' Hoodies.
