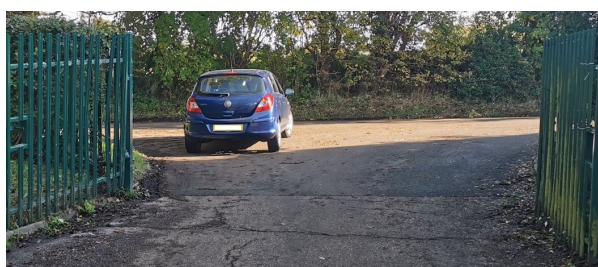
Governor Visits

Choosing a secondary school is a big decision, and our Virtual Open Evening is a fantastic way to meet our staff and students.

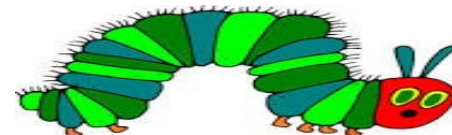
