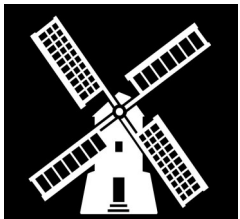

<p>Write a story set somewhere in Essex that you know well, Remember to describe the setting carefully so that your reader can recognise the place where it is set. How about an adventure story set around the idea of the Bocking Church tunnel?</p>	<p>Choose a selection of items in your house. Measure their length and width and then work out the perimeter (remember the perimeter is the distance all the way round the edge. Try items a table top, a rug, a book and so on.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Research a town or city in Essex and produce a factfile including lots of information about the place. Add pictures and suggestions of what you could do there.</p>
<p>Create a tourist advert to encourage people to visit Essex. Remember to include lots of persuasion and boastful language. You could present this as a poster, leaflet or even record yourself in a TV advert.</p>	<p>Create a poster for a times table that you think you need to practice.</p>	<p><u>Art</u> Draw a landscape picture or painting of a place in Essex. It could be somewhere you know really well, somewhere you have visited or somewhere you have found a photo of. Eg. Bocking Windmill, Colchester Castle Finchingfield duck pond, Walton Pier</p>
<p>Find a poem that you really like. Write and present it in your neatest handwriting and decorate it beautifully. For an extra challenge can you learn it so you can perform it to the rest of the class.</p>	<p>Log in to Deepening Understanding using your login. Complete one of the task set in your files, there will be different tasks set each week.</p>	<p><u>Science</u> Plan a healthy meal that contains all the food groups you should be eating. You can either try making the meal yourself with help from an adult (remember to take a photo to share) or create your own picture of the meal colour it carefully.</p>
<p>Write a review about a book that you have read, or a TV series or film that you have watched. Include enough detail to encourage others to want to read or watch it, but don't give away any important plot twists or the ending.</p>	<p>Use TTRS for 10 minutes every day for a week. Try to practice the tables you are less confident with using Jamming and then try some studio games to see if you can improve your status. Remember each game earns a point towards the class tournament and your House point total. You will earn 10 coins for each Garage game, 5 for a soundcheck and 1 point per game for all the others.</p>	<p><u>Geography</u> Draw a sketch map of the area where you live. Include your house and any road names you can. Could you extend sketch map to show your journey to school. Add any key features that you might see on the way.</p>
