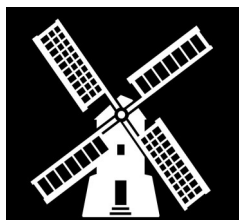

This might be the opening, build up, problem, resolution and ending.</i>	Complete a survey using a tally chart <i>You could count modes of transport, colour of cars, favourite take aways etc.</i>	Design a new vehicle. Draw and label your new design. <i>For example, a car that can drive and fly.</i>
